LONG BEACH, Calif., May 27, 2009 — While stating that “time is ticking and a lot of agencies are scrambling to get bicycle infrastructure projects in place to meet ARRA qualifications,” Andréa White-Kjoss, chief executive officer of [Mobis Transportation/Bikestation](#), today announced [MobisEDGE](#), a program designed to jump-start bicycle and transit center projects for agencies with site analysis, demand planning and cost estimates in four weeks.

Under the requirements of the **American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)**, agencies intending to allocate stimulus bill monies to bicycle infrastructure must obligate 50 percent of the funds within 180 days of the apportionment (funds not obligated within the designated period are recaptured and redistributed to other grantees that demonstrate that the funds can be spent within the stipulated time frame). The remaining funds must be spent within one year. Funding for [bicycle infrastructure](#) is eligible in the ARRA Enhancement Funding Category with \$4.7 million in available funds, State Fiscal Stabilization Funding with \$9.7 billion, Community Development Block Grants with \$1 billion, and Energy Efficiency Category with \$3.1 billion in available funds.

White-Kjoss stated, “A lot of agencies are realizing that they don’t have the time, people or information to meet the dates to obligate these funds. But they really want to incorporate ‘last mile’ [bicycle transit centers](#) into their transportation system to reduce

traffic congestion and meet commitments they've made for **carbon-neutral projects**. As the nation's only turnkey alternative transportation provider, Mobis/Bikestation is set up to help meet those deadlines and provides municipalities with cost effective alternative transit center systems. We have built and operated our own [Bikestation](#) facilities and know exactly what's required to get the job done."

The new **MobisEDGE** program includes an abbreviated on-site planning appraisal derived from the company's unique **SCORE site assessment** service. The appraisal starts with a bicycle accessibility and use analysis, as well as transport assessments and an evaluation of the interaction between pedestrian, bicycle and vehicular movements. The assessment analyzes the balance between access by public transport, walking and bicycle modes and the need for efficient servicing and parking demands.
