**MOBIS TRANSPORTATION/BIKESTATION SIGNS ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT  
FOR NEW BIKESTATION WASHINGTON, D.C.**

*Array of Bicycling Services Provided by Partner, Bike and Roll Washington, D.C.*

**Long Beach, Calif./Washington, D.C., October 2, 2009** — [Mobis Transportation/Bikestation](#), the nation's only turnkey [bicycle](#)/alternative transportation transit system, today announced it has signed an agreement with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) for the licensing of the Bikestation name and administration of all membership and access control of the new Bikestation Washington, D.C. The new flagship [bicycle transit](#) facility, which occupies prime real estate at Union Station just blocks from the Capitol, was designed, planned and executed in a public/private agreement between Mobis Transportation/Bikestation and DDOT.

According to Jim Sebastian, Supervisory Transportation Planner for DDOT, "Bikestation helped us understand and create a bike-transit center at Union Station that will be a huge boost to cycling in D.C. Under terms of the new agreement, Mobis Transportation/Bikestation will administer the membership and proprietary access control systems of the transit facility permitting members secure bicycle parking at the Bikestation 24 hours a day, seven days a week through an electronic key. Other services of the Bikestation, including daily staffing, bicycle repair, retail sales and bike rental will be provided in partnership with [Bike and Roll](#) Washington D.C., local entity of a national bike rental and tour company with operations in five major cities in the US.

Bikestation Washington, D.C. will open October 2, 2009.
